

Get printing on your iPhones & iPads (via Dropbox) in 4 easy steps!



1. Download

In the App Store, search for **sct**. You will be able to look for the printing app that looks like the screenshot in Fig 1.1. Install the app. This app can be downloaded **for free**.

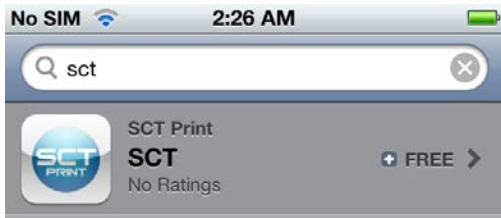

Upon successful installation, you can find the app icon on the home screen of your device, just like in Fig 1.2

2. Connect to WLAN-SMU

The app **only works** if your device is connected to the SMU network (WLAN-SMU). Do so in the *Wi-Fi* segment of your *Settings*, as shown in Fig 2.1. Note that your username is in the form john.doe.2012. Once you are successfully connected, you will see the screenshot in Fig 2.2.

Now, you are ready to perform Dropbox syncing.

3. Sync with Dropbox & Select Document

Launch the printing app. You will see the screen as in Fig 3.1. Tap on *Documents / Print* to see Fig 3.2. Once there, tap on *Dropbox* to view your documents in Dropbox.

3. Sync with Dropbox & Select Document (continued)

You will see the screenshot as of Fig. 3.3. Select your login settings, and tap on *Open Dropbox*. This takes you to the screenshot as of Fig 3.4. Enter your Dropbox email & password to login. Note that after the first login, you will not need to login again. Once you are logged in, navigate to the file you intend to send for printing. Once there, you will see Fig 3.5. Tap on the document you to select it. This brings you to the screenshot as of Fig 3.6. Once there, tap on *Print*. **Note:** This app only supports the following formats as of **Appendix A**.

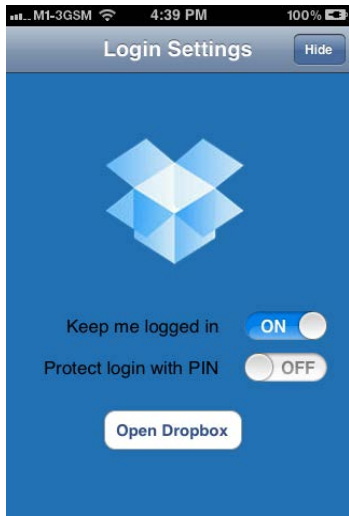

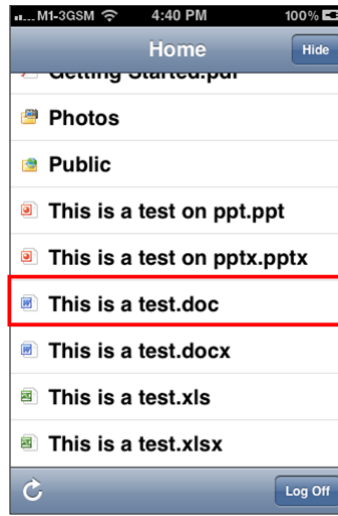

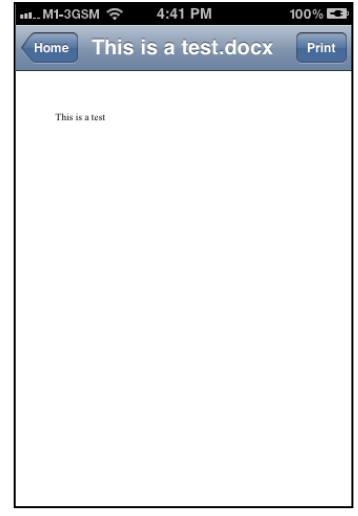

4. Send Print Job

You will see the screenshot as of Fig 4.1. Ensure that your *Host Name / IP Address* is set to 10.7.3.130. **Remember that your device needs to be connected to WLAN-SMU in order to send print jobs.** Input your *User ID* in the format mary.lim.2012 or, as in Fig 4.1, john.doe.2012. (User ID is case insensitive) Check the settings of your print job too. Once done, tap on *Print*. You will see the *Printing in progress* box appear. Once this box disappears, you are ready to collect your print job at any of SMU's printing counters, just like how you sent print jobs on your laptop.

FAQ



Q1	What is SCT mobile print app?
	SCT Mobile is an official mobile application developed by Seng City to allow students to print documents from their Apple mobile devices. These devices include the iPhone (3GS, 4, 4S), iPad, iPad 2 and the new iPad.
Q2	Is the SCT mobile print app available for Android mobile devices?
	No. The SCT mobile print app is currently available for the Apple IOS devices only. We will channel to the vendor to develop the Android version if the IOS version proves successful
Q3	What is the Operating System required by the SCT mobile print app?
	SCT mobile print app requires IOS version 5.1 and 5.1.1. The IOS version 6 app is current pending approval from Apple. Once it had been approved, it will be available on the App store for download. The tentative date is first week of Dec 2012.
Q4	What kind of documents can I print from my mobile devices?
	SCT will print files from your Dropbox storage with the file extensions *.pdf, *.doc, *.docx, *.xls, *.xlsx, *.ppt and *.pptx via Dropbox However, for documents attached within your emails, only .pdf, .doc, .xls and .ppt files can be printed.
Q5	Do I need to pay to download the SCT mobile print app?
	The SCT mobile print app is free of charge for all SMU students.
Q6	Can I send my print job if I am only connected to any of the Singapore Telcos 3G networks?
	No, SCT mobile print app will only send the print job when the mobile device is connected to the campus WLAN-SMU network
Q7	How can I make a feature requests or report a bug?
