## Configuring iPhone/iPad to Access Internet via "eduroam"



1. Go to **Settings** 

Click to Wi-Fi



2. Look for **eduroam** and click it.





3. You'll be prompted to key in your email address and password. Enter your SMU email address and password.



## Example:

Faculty/Staff:- username will be <a href="mailto:xxxx@smu.edu.sg">xxxx@smu.edu.sg</a>


Student:- username will be <a href="mailto:xxxx@business.smu.edu.sg">xxxx@sis.smu.edu.sg</a>, etc.

- 4. Click the **Join** button.
- 5. You'll be prompted to accept a certificate. Click **Accept.**





6. When a check icon appears beside the wireless name **eduroam**, you would have successfully connected to the **eduroam** network.



(Note: For Apple iOS (iPod touch/iPhone/iPad) users, please upgrade your device to the latest version of iOS should you encounter any difficulty connecting to SSID eduroam. Please try to join the network again if you are prompted with an error. If the error persists after a few tries, please click on "Forget this Network" on your current network profile and connect again to SSID eduroam.)
